Henry Morris of Clay co
AND

The heirs of William Morris dec'd: David McCollum and Rachel his wife; George Morris and his wife; William Morris and Margaret his wife; **Robert Morris and Susan his wife**; William McCollum and Nancy his wife (signed as William McClure and Nancy his wife); all of Clay co and James Davidson and Polly his wife; William Bales and Susan his wife, all of Hendricks co Indiana; and Joseph York and Rhoda his wife

Tr: In consideration of six and one fourth cents, Henry Morris, having paid diverse debts of “**our dec'd father William Morris**, amounting to \$300” – conveyance now to Henry “all our rights to land our father lived on and possessed at his death, lying on the south bank of the south fork of the Ky River, at the mouth of Catfish Branch, containing 70 acres.”
